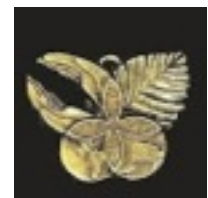
“NURTURING THE CARING COMMUNITY”

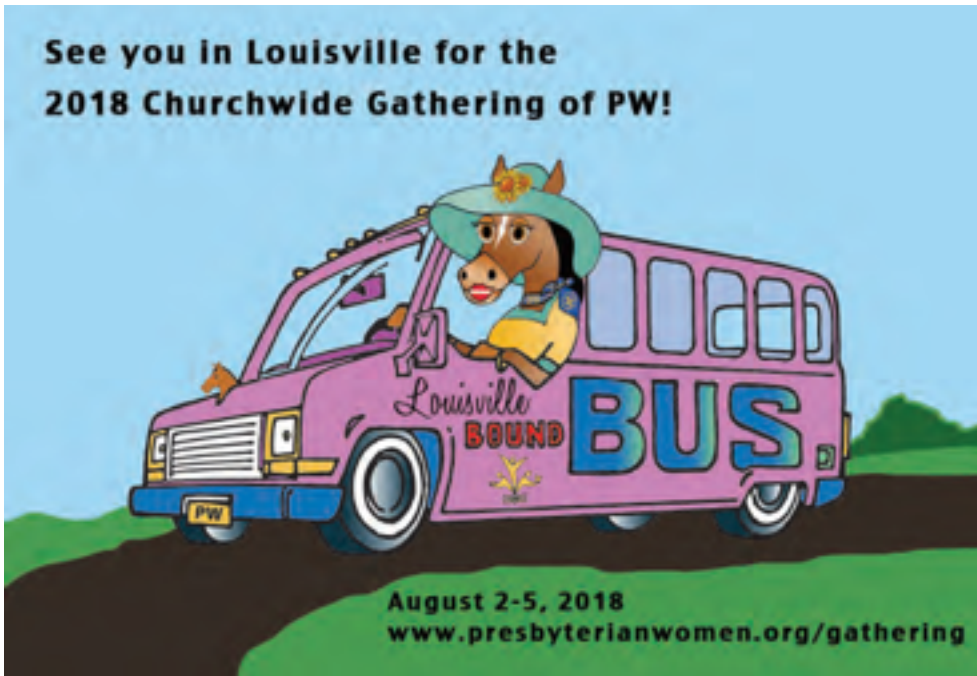
